THE PROGRAM'S WINNING TRADITION IS BUILT ON THE FOUNDATIONAL PRINCIPLES OF THE CHRISTIAN FAITH AND SERVICE TO THE LARGER COMMUNITY AND TO EACH OTHER. THESE CORE THEMES, COUPLED WITH A COMMITMENT TO EXCELLENCE, DEFINE THE HOCKEY EXPERIENCE AT BSM. THEY HAVE BEEN THE FOUNDATION OF THE TEAMS OF THE PAST. THEY WILL CONTINUE TO SHAPE THE TEAMS OF THE FUTURE AND THE HISTORY OF RED KNIGHT HOCKEY GOING FORWARD.

THE BENILDE HIGH SCHOOL HOCKEY PROGRAM WAS BORN IN 1958, WHEN ALL PRACTICE AND PLAY REMAINED OUTDOORS. THE RED KNIGHTS WERE INITIALLY COACHED BY GENE SACK AND PLAYED IN THE CATHOLIC CENTRAL LAKES CONFERENCE WHERE THEY WON FOUR LEAGUE TITLES AND MADE FOUR TRIPS TO THE CATHOLIC STATE TOURNAMENT.

IN 1977, THE PROGRAM WON ITS FIRST AND ONLY CONFERENCE TITLE IN THE DON BOSCO CONFERENCE, WHEN THEY ADVANCED TO THE REGION V SEMIFINALS UNDER THE OLD ONE-CLASS TOURNAMENT FORMAT.

IN 1990, CURRENT HEAD COACH, KEN PAULY JOINED THE TEAM AND LED THE RED KNIGHTS TO WIN THE FIRST CONFERENCE TITLE IN THE MISSOTA CONFERENCE. UNDER PAULY'S LEADERSHIP THE TEAM SAW GREAT SUCCESS, WHICH MOVED BSM INTO THE UPPER ECHELON OF THE MINNESOTA HIGH SCHOOL HOCKEY ELITE PROGRAMS.

IN 1999, BSM WON ITS FIRST CLASS A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.

IN 1974, BENILDE HIGH SCHOOL AND ST. MARGARET'S ACADEMY MERGED AND THE PROGRAM BECAME BSM HOCKEY. THE PROGRAM THEN SWITCHED TO THE DON BOSCO CONFERENCE AS A UNIFIED INSTITUTION.

IN 1985, BSM JOINED THE MISSOTA CONFERENCE, PLAYING TEAMS SUCH AS BURNSVILLE, LAKEVILLE, PRIOR LAKE, NORTHFIELD AND HOLY ANGELS.

IN 1998, ONCE AGAIN THE PROGRAM SWITCHED TO A NEW CONFERENCE: THE METRO ALLIANCE. THE TEAM FOUND MAJOR SUCCESS HERE WITH SIX LEAGUE TITLES IN SEVEN SEASONS

WITH YET ANOTHER CONFERENCE CHANGE, THE BOYS HEADED TO THE NORTH SUBURBAN CONFERENCE AND COLLECTED SEVEN STRAIGHT CONFERENCE TITLES.

AFTER A 3-YEAR BREAK FROM THE TEAM, HEAD COACH KEN PAULY RETURNED TO THE PROGRAM. THE TEAM WON THE SECTION 6AA TITLE AND WENT ON TO PLACE 3RD IN THE STATE TOURNAMENT OVERALL.

IN 2018, BSM SECURED ITS THIRD METRO WEST TITLE, AND THE SCHOOL'S OVERALL 21ST CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP. THIS SEASON WAS A MAJOR COMEBACK FOR THE TEAM AFTER GRADUATING MOST OF THEIR TEAM THE PRIOR YEAR.

IN 2014, BSM JOINED THE METRO WEST CONFERENCE AND REMAIN IN THIS CONFERENCE TODAY.

IN 2012, BSM CLIMBED HIGH SCHOOL HOCKEY'S HIGHEST MOUNTAIN BY WINNING THE CLASS AA STATE CHAMPIONSHIP. THE MINNEAPOLIS STAR TRIBUNE CALLED IT ONE OF THE "MOST SENTIMENTAL RUNS EVER" AS THE TEAM BATTLED THROUGH A LIFE-CHANGING INJURY TO ONE OF ITS PLAYERS, JACK JABLONSKI.

IN 2019, THE TEAM HAD A 20-WIN SEASON, FINISHING WITH A TOP-10 RANKING. SINCE THEN, THE RED KNIGHTS HAVE FINISHED AT THE TOP OF ITS CONFERENCE AND 2ND IN SECTION 6AA.

COACH'S CORNER: KEN PAULY

COACH KEN PAULY HAS 36 YEARS OF HIGH SCHOOL HOCKEY COACHING UNDER HIS BELT. WITH 33 OF THOSE COACHING YEARS AT BSM, PAULY HAS LED THE RED KNIGHTS TO CLASS A STATE TITLES IN 1999 AND 2001. HE ALSO TOOK THE TEAM TO ITS FIRST CLASS AA STATE TOURNAMENT, CLAIMING THIRD-PLACE HONORS IN 2008, AND WON THE PROGRAM'S FIRST AA TITLE IN 2012.

DURING HIS YEARS AS RED KNIGHT HEAD COACH, PAULY HAS AMASSED THREE STATE TITLES, 15 CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIPS, AND HAS COMPILED A 503-237-27 RECORD, MAKING HIM THE WINNINGEST COACH IN BSM'S 62-YEAR HISTORY. IN ALL OF HIS 36 YEARS AS A HEAD COACH, HIS RECORD IS 547-268-34, RANKING HIM 10TH IN CAREER VICTORIES AMONG MINNESOTA COACHES AND SECOND AMONG ACTIVE COACHES.

PAULY IS A LIFETIME MEMBER OF THE MN COACHES ASSOCIATION AND CURRENTLY SITS ON THE HERB BROOKS FOUNDATION'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS.



PAULY TEACHES FULL-TIME, IS CHAIR OF BSM'S SOCIAL STUDIES DEPARTMENT, AND IS AN AWARD-WINNING TEACHER. HE EARNED THE SCHOOL'S FACULTY OF THE YEAR AWARD IN 2012 AND THE RED KNIGHT LEADERSHIP AWARD IN 2015. HE WAS CHOSEN AS BSM'S COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER IN 1997 AND IN 2018. HE RECEIVED HIS 20 YEARS OF SERVICE HONOR AS A FACULTY MEMBER.

PAULY EARNED A BACHELOR OF ARTS DEGREE IN HISTORY FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA IN 1989. HE AND HIS WIFE, ANNE MARIE DOMINGUEZ, AN ENGLISH TEACHER AT BSM, RESIDE IN PLYMOUTH. THEY HAVE TWO CHILDREN; CAROLINE, 22, WHO ATTENDS THE UNIVERSITY OF MADISON WISCONSIN, AND A.J., 19, WHO PLAYED FOR THE BSM HOCKEY PROGRAM AND IS ATTENDING THE DUNWOODY INSTITUTE.

JOHN RUSSO VARSITY ASSISTANT COACH

JOHN RUSSO RETURNS FOR HIS 16TH SEASON AT BSM, WHERE HE COACHES THE RED KNIGHTS' DEFENSE AND IS IN CHARGE OF THE TEAM'S PENALTY-KILLING UNIT. HE CAME TO BSM IN 2007 AFTER FILLING A SIMILAR ROLE ON KEN PAULY'S STAFF AT MINNETONKA HIGH SCHOOL.

IN HIS 26 YEARS AS A HIGH SCHOOL COACH, RUSSO IS RECOGNIZED AS ONE OF THE TOP ASSISTANT COACHES IN HIGH SCHOOL HOCKEY. HE HAS SERVED AS A HEAD COACH IN THE HIGHLY-REGARDED UPPER MIDWEST HIGH SCHOOL ELITE LEAGUE AND HAS BEEN A MEMBER OF FIVE STATE TOURNAMENT COACHING STAFFS. ADDITIONALLY, HE HAS EARNED A TOTAL OF FIVE SECTION ASSISTANT COACH OF THE YEAR AWARDS, THREE THROUGHOUT HIS TIME AT BSM (2008, 2012, 2018).

IN 2015, RUSSO WAS NAMED THE CHAIRMAN OF THE HOBEBY BAKER COMMITTEE, TASKED WITH CHOOSING COLLEGE HOCKEY'S TOP PLAYER, AND REMAINS AS A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS. OUTSIDE OF COACHING, RUSSO IS AN ATTORNEY WHO RESIDES IN PLYMOUTH WITH HIS WIFE AND FAMILY.

DERRICK RAYMOND ENTERS HIS NINTH SEASON WITH THE BSM HOCKEY PROGRAM, FILLING SEVERAL ROLES. HE NOW PULLS DOUBLE DUTY AS AN ASSISTANT COACH AND THE TEAM'S DIRECTOR OF OPERATIONS, PROVIDING ANALYSIS AND OTHER DUTIES RELATED TO TEAM OPERATIONS.

PRIOR TO JOINING THE RED KNIGHTS, HE WORKED FOR SIX YEARS AS A MEMBER OF THE STAFF AT ROBBINSDALE COOPER HIGH SCHOOL.

HIGHLY INVOLVED IN YOUTH SPORTS, RAYMOND HAS SERVED IN NUMEROUS CAPACITIES FOR THE ARMSTRONG-COOPER YOUTH HOCKEY ASSOCIATION, WHERE HE IS A MEMBER OF THE ACVHA PLAYER DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE.

RAYMOND CURRENTLY RESIDES IN NEW HOPE WITH HIS WIFE, JESSICA, AND THEIR FOUR CHILDREN, JEFF, A FRESHMAN AT DRAKE UNIVERSITY, JOHN, NATALIE AND NICOLE.



CASEY MAIKKULA VARSITY ASSISTANT COACH

CASEY MAIKKULA IS ENTERING HIS 14TH SEASON AS A HIGH SCHOOL HOCKEY COACH AND FIFTH SEASON WITH THE RED KNIGHTS.

PRIOR TO JOINING COACH PAULY'S STAFF, CASEY SERVED AS AN ASSISTANT COACH AT VARIOUS HIGH SCHOOLS, INCLUDING A THREE-YEAR STINT AT MAPLE GROVE. WHILE AT MAPLE GROVE, MAIKKULA HELPED BOTH THE BOYS AND GIRLS TEAMS REACH THE STATE TOURNAMENT FOR THE SECOND TIME IN THEIR HISTORIES; THE BOYS IN 2016-2017, AND THE GIRLS IN 2018-2019.

SINCE JOINING THE RED KNIGHTS IN THE FALL OF 2017, MAIKKULA HAS BEEN TASKED WITH VARIOUS RESPONSIBILITIES, RANGING FROM ON-ICE SKILL DEVELOPMENT TO OFF-ICE SCOUTING AND SOCIAL MEDIA COORDINATION.

MAIKKULA EARNED A BACHELOR OF SCIENCE DEGREE IN MARKETING FROM METROPOLITAN STATE UNIVERSITY IN 2012 AND HAS SERVED AS A SOCIAL MEDIA CONSULTANT FOR PROFESSIONAL ATHLETES, MUSICIANS, AND OTHER PUBLIC FIGURES SINCE 2010.

GRANT HOLLER IS IN HIS THIRD SEASON AS THE RED KNIGHTS' GOALTENDING COACH, WORKING WITH BOTH THE VARSITY AND JV GOALIES.

AFTER HOLLER'S HIGH SCHOOL CAREER, HE SPENT TWO SEASONS IN THE NAJHL FOR THE GRANITE CITY LUMBERJACKS AND BREEZY POINT NORTH STARS. IN HIS ROOKIE SEASON WITH THE LUMBERJACKS, HOLLER SAW ACTION IN 14 GAMES, POSTED A 3.06 GOALS AGAINST AVERAGE AND HELPED HIS TEAM TO THE NAJHL TITLE. AFTER TWO SEASONS OF JUNIOR HOCKEY, HOLLER ATTENDED THE UNIVERSITY OF ST. THOMAS, WHERE HE DOUBLE MAJORED IN BUSINESS LAW AND SPANISH LINGUISTICS.

HOLLER BRINGS DIVERSE COACHING EXPERIENCE FROM PAST INTERNSHIPS WITH BANDITS GOALIE SCHOOL IN MICHIGAN AND CROSSFIT FAST FACTORY IN ST. CLOUD, MINNESOTA.

IN ADDITION TO COACHING AND DEVELOPING ATHLETES, GRANT COACHES GOALIES FOR FORTIS ACADEMY AND WORKS IN COMPLIANCE IN THE FINANCIAL SERVICES INDUSTRY.

GRANT BESSE VOLUNTEER ASSISTANT COACH

GRANT BESSE, BSM ALUMNI AND 2013 MR. HOCKEY AWARD WINNER, HAS RETURNED TO BSM AFTER A FOUR-YEAR COLLEGIATE CAREER AT THE UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN-MADISON AND A FIVE-YEAR PROFESSIONAL CAREER.

BESSE LED THE RED KNIGHT HOCKEY TEAM TO A 5-1 VICTORY IN THE 2012 STATE CLASS AA CHAMPIONSHIP GAME, SCORING ALL FIVE GOALS, INCLUDING THE FINAL THREE SHORT-HANDED. BESSE WAS A THREE-TIME ALL-NORTH SUBURBAN CONFERENCE HONOREE AND NAMED THE ASSOCIATED PRESS PLAYER OF THE YEAR IN 2013. HE WAS ALSO AN AP FIRST-TEAM ALL-STATE PICK DURING BOTH HIS JUNIOR AND SENIOR YEARS.

BESSE WAS A TWO - SPORT HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETE, EARNING VARSITY LETTERS IN BOTH HOCKEY AND BASEBALL. AS A FOUR-YEAR BSM VARSITY HOCKEY LETTER WINNER, HE SCORED 50 POINTS IN ALL FOUR OF HIS SEASONS. BESSE STILL HOLDS MANY SCHOOL HOCKEY RECORDS, INCLUDING MOST CAREER GOALS AND TOP TEN CAREER POINTS. WE ARE HAPPY TO HAVE GRANT BESSE BACK ON THE RED KNIGHT ROSTER.



CHRIS MCGOWAN JUNIOR VARSITY HEAD COACH

CHRIS MCGOWAN GRADUATED FROM BSM IN 1991 AND IS RETURNING FOR HIS 16TH SEASON AS THE RED KNIGHTS' JUNIOR VARSITY HEAD COACH WHERE HE LED THE TEAM TO AN IMPRESSIVE 226-112-27 RECORD.

MCGOWAN WAS PART OF PAULY'S FIRST VARSITY TEAM AT BSM AND HAS SPENT OVER A DECADE COACHING YOUTH HOCKEY. HE WAS A THREE-SPORT ATHLETE DURING HIS PREP CAREER—COMPETING IN HOCKEY, SOCCER AND TENNIS.

MCGOWAN PLAYED SOCCER FOR FOUR YEARS AT ST. MARY'S UNIVERSITY IN WINONA, MINN., WHERE HE RECEIVED HIS BACHELOR'S DEGREE. HE WENT ON TO GET AN MBA FROM THE F.W.
